### A Journey of Healing & Hope

\*Ethan's life was a struggle from the start. With his father absent and his mother battling addiction, he was alone and without hope. During his time with us in Residential Interventions, he never had a single visitor.

Ethan's time with us was marked by a deep mistrust in adults, stemming from his mother's broken promises. He engaged in various services, including individual and group therapy, where our team worked tirelessly to help him rebuild his trust.

Before coming to NewPath, Ethan had spent some time in foster care. Unfortunately, this period was turbulent, marked by behavioral issues and further deepening his mistrust of adults.

*Ethan's interest in wildlife and the outdoors became his sanctuary, offering him comfort and peace. This connection to nature was key to his healing.*

*With time and support, Ethan began to thrive. Now, he is in a loving foster home surrounded by animals, providing him with stability and love. He has returned to school and is excelling.*
